Agreement for (name of student)

1. **We** (parents or guardians) understand that submitting this application does not in itself guarantee that our child will be found an exchange partner. Moreover, the Association Bordeaux Bristol maintains the right to refuse any application from students who fail to provide sufficient guarantee of appropriate behaviour and conduct.
2. We agree to the registration fee of **€30** (administrative costs) + €250 (deposit) - that is a total of **€280** - and accept that **the fee of €30 is non returnable**, even in the case of cancellation, whatever the reason. The balance - **€300** - will be payable as soon as we know the name of our child's French partner. The payment **deadline is 15th March 2021**.
3. If we apply later than the deadline given by the Association, any extra expense with regards to the original flight booking price will be covered by us, the parents. Likewise, if we choose to alter our child's flight out or back, we, the parents, will cover the extra expense incurred as well as the cost of the original flight.
4. If we withdraw after the pairing has been agreed, the total cost of the exchange will still be payable. All fees paid will be retained by the Association, unless the withdrawal is as a result of serious accident, illness or death. Any such justification should comply with the MAIF cancellation insurance policy. In other circumstances, no refund is payable because an ongoing pairing has been established.
5. We accept the principle of a reciprocal exchange so we undertake to welcome the French student for the agreed period. Should we fail to do this, we will reimburse the Association for the expense of placing the student in another family as a paying guest.
N.B.: The presence of our child is **compulsory** during the whole of his/her correspondent's stay. Please contact us in case of any unavoidable school trip such as Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.
6. If conditions in the host family prove unsuitable or do not meet the description given on the application form, we will inform the accompanying teacher at the earliest opportunity. In such a case a new host family will be found. If we refuse this arrangement and decide instead to bring our child home, it will be at our own expense and we will not be entitled to any refund.
7. If the organizers of the exchange judge our child's behaviour to be unacceptable and feel compelled to send him/her home, we understand that we will have to cover the extra expense (cf.: Code of Conduct).
8. We understand that during our child's stay in France he/she will be the Association's responsibility. We undertake to keep the Association aware of any medical issues concerning our child and we agree to authorise the Association's representative (Schools' exchange manager, President or Vice-president) to approve such medical treatment for our child as is deemed necessary in an emergency or upon the advice of a qualified medical practitioner.
9. If we cannot pick our child up from the airport on his/her return, we will let the *Association* know in advance the name and address of the person who will come in our place and we will ensure that that person brings proof of identity. If neither parent nor representative is present to pick our child up, the *Association* can no longer be held responsible for him/her.

10. We authorise the Association to use appropriate images of our child solely for the purpose of promoting the exchange and on the understanding that our child will not be identified. (delete as appropriate): **YES** **NO**

12. We declare that no member of our family is on the DBS children’s barred list.
13. We would be happy to be visited by the accompanying teacher during the French student’s stay.
14. We confirm that, during the French student’s stay, every enclosed space, including the car, will be a no-smoking area.
15. We cannot hold the *Association Bordeaux-Bristol* responsible for activities offered to our child during his/her stay in France.
16. We will inform the *Association* and the French parents of any stay away from the usual family home.
17. The terms of the MAIF Raqvam Associations & Collectives insurance policy specifically exclude cover in respect of the following:
- any occurrence, damage or wilful misconduct deliberately caused by the participant.
 - pre-existing illness, accident or medical conditions
 - pre-existing pregnancy or termination of pregnancy
 - cancellation linked to an epidemic, pandemic or any measures taken by the authorities in relation to such an epidemic or pandemic.

USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Personal information collected from this application form by the *Association* is used for purposes of administration (establishing a list of participants, banking cheques, sending participants reminders about meetings and events and information necessary for its functioning and activities) These personal details are handled by officers of the *Association*; they are not shared publicly and are kept on a secure database. In accordance with the European ruling of 27th April 2016 on the collection and processing of personal information (GDPR), you have a right to see the personal data we hold on you and check that we are processing it lawfully.
